Eligibility criteria: Grade 9-12 student of any Perry County, OH School HOME SCHOOL ENTRIES ARE WELCOME & ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE!

Purpose: To encourage communication between youth and members of our community who may be several generations older and can offer a historic perspective & lesson on "trash and recycling" ...and living a more sustainable lifestyle.

STUDENT PROJECT GUIDELINES: ✓ LIST SUBMIT BY: FEB 25, 2022
Get permission from someone 65 or older to do recorded interview. Be polite, courteous & respectful during interview. Remember to thank them for taking time with you.
Have that person sign the release form giving permission for the interview to be uploaded and archived to PCDL (PC District Library) website "The Digital Shoebox Project"
Record and retain your interview. <u>Record on your own device or PCDL has recorders to borrow your choice</u> . <u>Email submitted recording in a usable format</u> .
In the interview, introduce yourself and the topic (ex. Hello, my name is and today I am interviewing my grandparent/ family friend/ neighbor to discuss use your own words. Be original! * interview time length suggestion: 10 to 15 minutes
Take photo together. Get permission for photo too!
Essay needs to be typed, double spaced; no more than 300 words. Be original, creative and informative, using proper spelling, grammar & usage. NO Student name on the front of the essay. Email essay in word format; email application, release form & photo as PDF.
Essay should have an <u>introduction</u> , <u>main body and conclusion</u> . <u>Conclusion paragraph</u> <u>should describe what was learned from the interview; anything student pledges to do differently in his/her lifestyle to reduce/reuse/recycle (live more sustainably) as a result of your interview.</u>
SUBMIT: application PCDL interview release form recording essay photo
Interview questions:
<ol> <li>How did you &amp; your family "Use it up, wear it out, make it do, or do without" (REDUCE, REUSE, RECYCLE, ROT philosophy) back in the 30's, 40's and 50's compared to today?</li> </ol>
2. How has our trash changed since you were a child? (specific to types of materials)
